Purpose

The purpose of this study is to select a range of different products and technologies that could provide the type of platform to meet the needs of the Hastings Community Planning Resource website.

Approach

There are many choices on the market and many that offer various options and ways of achieving what is required of this project. Taking into account the above information and key areas for scoring, I have split up your technological choices into several main key areas, which are:

1. Bespoke Website using ASP and MS-SQL
2. Bespoke Website using PHP and MySQL
3. Open Source CMS (PHP & MySQL)
4. Wiki
5. Blog

Bespoke Website using ASP and MS-SQL or PHP and MySQL

If you want to be able to retain full rights to everything on your website including your programming and self developed scripts this is the way to go. Bespoke websites are tailor made to your specifications and you are capable of doing far more this way than any other. However, this all does come at a cost, not just in development time but in testing. Bespoke websites also take far longer to develop as you are in essence starting from scratch with no foundation.

Open Source CMS (PHP & MySQL)

An option that is becoming more and more popular, not just with individuals but also big companies and organisations worldwide. Greenpeace International and IBM both use Drupal for their websites. Open Source brings the cost down to zero for a license but costs may be incurred for bespoke modules or pay-for modules. The huge benefit of Open Source is not just cost but also the support of a worldwide community of developers and

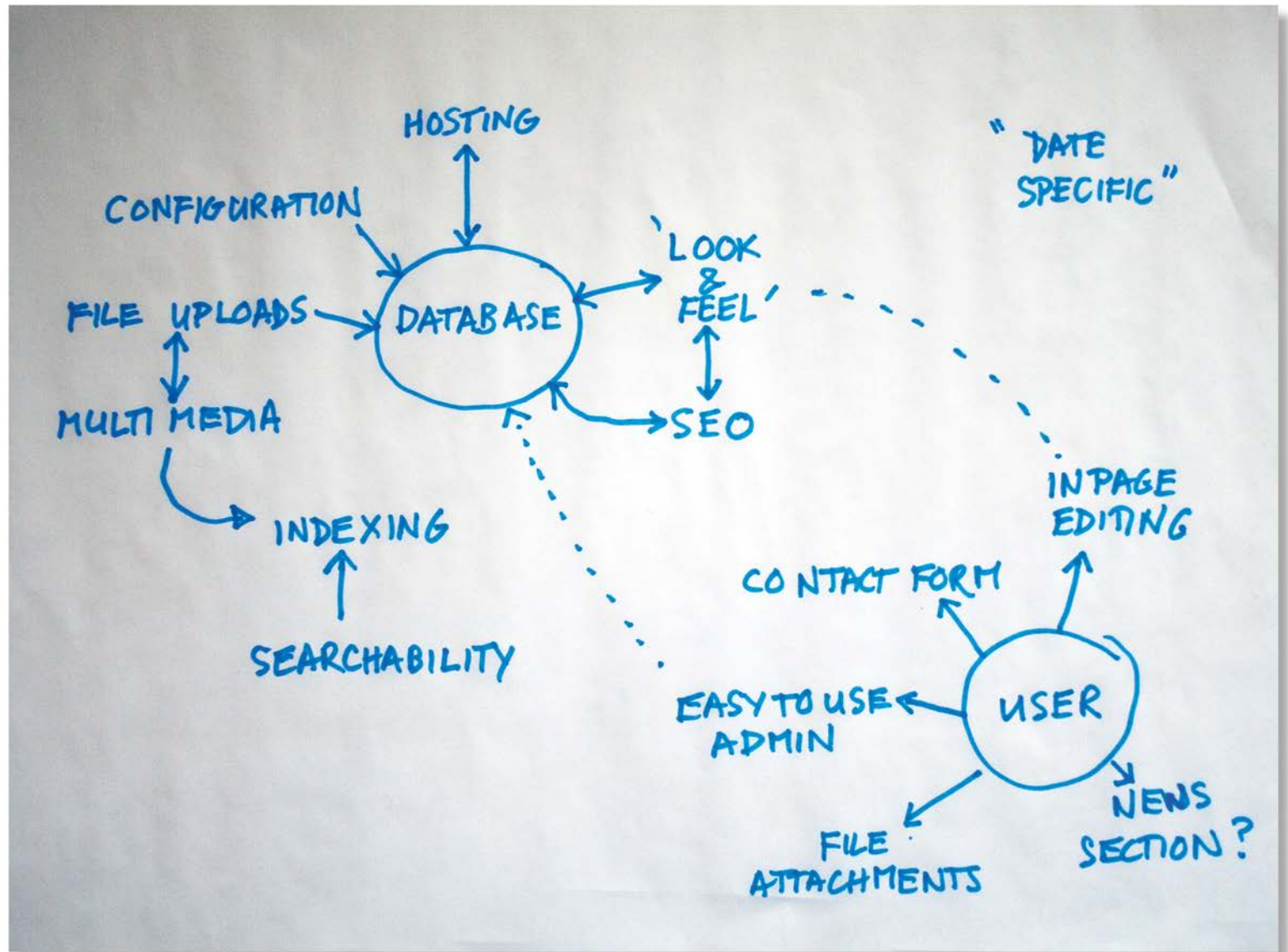
