Together with a rediscovered uncensored version of the documentary *A roof of my own* (UNTV 1964, 29 minutes), which portrays the development and patterns of community building in self-build-neighbourhoods in Lima/ Peru, recently initiated work on a follow-up documentary directed by Kathrin Golda-Pongratz will be presented, to illustrate the transformation processes of the *El Ermitaño* neighbourhood and its contemporary challenges and to set out the development goals for the future of the portrayed and other comparable urban settlements.
